* In order to qualify for Club Grants or Global Grants in the 2018-2019 Rotary year, a club's 2017-2018 President and 2018-2019 President must have attended grant management training. If a club has more than 25 members, a separate Foundation Chair must also have attended the training. In order to complete the training, an individual must complete both part one AND part two of the training offered at District Assembly. Once an individual has been through training, he/she is certified for life and is not required to re-train in subsequent years.
