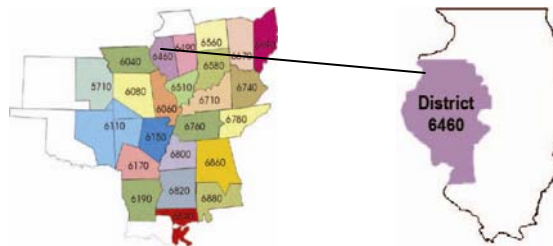

Paul P. Harris

The Founder of Rotary

(1868-1947)

Paul P. Harris, a lawyer, was the **founder of Rotary**, the world's first and most international service club. Rotary is an organization of business and professional leaders united worldwide to provide humanitarian service, promote high ethical standards in all vocations, and help build goodwill and peace in the world.

Born in Racine, Wisconsin, U.S.A. on 19 April 1868, Paul was the second of six children born to George N. Harris and Cornelia Brian Harris. At age 3 he moved to Wallingford, Vermont where he grew up in the care of his paternal grandparents. Married to Jean Thomas Harris (1881-1963), they had no children. He received an LL.B. from the University of Iowa and received an honorary LL.D. from the University of Vermont.

In 1896, he went to Chicago to practice law. One evening Paul went with a professional friend to his suburban home. After dinner, as they strolled through the neighborhood, Paul's friend introduced him to various tradesmen in their stores. This reminded Paul of his New England village and it occurred to him, "Why not have a fellowship composed of businessmen from different occupations, without restrictions of politics or religion?"

On 23 February 1905, Paul Harris formed the first Rotary Club with three other businessmen: Silvester Schiele, a coal merchant, Gustavus Loehr, a mining engineer, and Hiram Shorey, a merchant tailor. Paul Harris named the new club "Rotary" because members met in rotation at their various places of business. When Paul Harris became president of the club in its third year, he was convinced that the Rotary club could be developed into an important service movement and strove to extend Rotary to other cities.

When President emeritus Paul Harris passed away on 27 January 1947, his dream had grown from an informal meeting of four men to some 6,000 Rotary clubs developed for the purpose of service and fellowship.

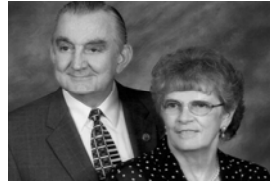
Presidential Citation

This year’s citation program serves as a guide your club can use to *Make Dreams Real*. Based on the four Avenues of Service and membership growth, it provides a framework for a healthy, vibrant club. I encourage your club to achieve the citation, not as a source of additional honor but as a way to ensure that your club is making a difference in the world. The program is also open to two of our partners in service, Rotaract and Interact, as a means of focusing and increasing the good that Rotary does in the world.

To qualify for a citation, your club should initiate a service project that will reduce child mortality and complete the membership goal and one activity from each of the five categories listed in this brochure between 1 July 2008 and 31 March 2009. The scope of the activities should be in proportion to the number of Rotarians in your club and their abilities, interests, and skills. Once your club has met this challenge, complete the certification form and submit it to your district governor by 31 March 2009. Governors must submit a list of certified clubs to RI World Headquarters, and it must arrive by 15 April 2009.

Richard Passmore District 6460 Governor 2008-2009



Richard “Dick” Passmore was born in Oak Park, Illinois, and has lived in Minneapolis, Minnesota, as well as Evanston, Park Ridge and Arlington Heights, all in Illinois. He graduated from Arlington High School where he first met his wife, Susan. Dick attended the University of Illinois in Champaign-Urbana for two years and then attended four additional years at the University of Illinois College of Dentistry in Chicago.

After graduation, Dick, who had entered the Naval Reserves as a freshman dental student, was assigned to the U.S. Naval Air Station, Barbers Point, Oahu, Hawaii. Dick served for three years there as assistant dental officer and then extended his active duty one year at Great Lakes Naval Station. After release from active duty, Dick joined world renowned dentist Dr. Robert Barkley in his dental practice in Macomb, Illinois, where Dick has practiced since 1970. Dick remained in the Naval Reserve until June 1987 when he retired with the rank of Commander.

Dick was sponsored for membership in the Rotary Club of Macomb by his mentor, Dr. Robert Barkley, in 1970. He has served as Chairman of the Rotary Information and New Member Orientation Committee, Centennial Club President, and Assistant District Governor. Dick’s inspiration to serve beyond the club level was an address by Past RI President, Cliff Dochterman, “When did YOU become a Rotarian?” at the District 6460 Conference in Springfield in 2000. Dick and Susan are Paul Harris Fellows, Major Donors to the Permanent Fund of Rotary International, and Dick is a Paul Harris Society member. In November 2007 Dick traveled with a group of Rotarians to Nigeria to serve in a National Immunization Day. Dick has 24 years of perfect attendance.

The Four-Way Test

From the earliest days of the organization, Rotarians were concerned with promoting high ethical standards in their professional lives. One of the world's most widely printed and quoted statements of business ethics is The Four-Way Test, which was created in 1932 by Rotarian Herbert J. Taylor (who later served as RI President) when he was asked to take charge of a company that was facing bankruptcy.

This 24-word test for employees to follow in their business and professional lives became the guide for sales, production, advertising, and all relations with dealers and customers, and the survival of the company is credited to this simple philosophy. Adopted by Rotary in 1943, The Four-Way Test has been translated into more than a hundred languages and published in thousands of ways. It asks the following four questions:

“Of the things we think, say or do:

- 1. Is it the TRUTH?**
- 2. Is it FAIR to all concerned?**
- 3. Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?**
- 4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?**

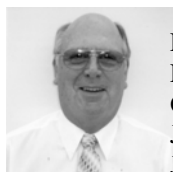
